Torth Shore transportation has been one of my top priorities since I was elected as your MLA. My previous experience as a professional engineer and background in transportation serve me well as I work on solutions to get the North Shore moving again.

It was an honour to lead the Integrated North Shore **Transportation and Planning** Project (INSTPP) in 2018, which brought federal, provincial, municipal, and First Nations governments and transportation agencies together to work collectively on improving transportation on the North Shore.

INSTPP is the first time key public transportation agencies have come together to establish a comprehensive understanding of the North Shore's transportation challenges and produce a unified, actionable approach for moving forward as a region. The final report summarizes a large body of work conducted with a level of inter-agency collaboration that is unprecedented.

There is no silver bullet when it comes to resolving our transportation challenges. Decisions must be evidence-based and informed by the analysis of real traffic data and the application of best practices.

Many pragmatic solutions are already underway as a result of the work of INSTPP. I'm also pleased to share that we are proceeding with a feasibility study for a fixed-link rapid transit solution to the North Shore.

This exciting announcement is just one of many that we've been able to share with you so far. I look forward to bringing you much more good news as I continue to work hard for you as your MLA.

Housing Security and Affordability in B.C.

- 17,000 new affordable homes already built or underway.
- Taxing real estate speculators and vacant homes.
- Cracking down on tax evasion and condo flipping.
- Investigating criminal money laundering and its impacts on the housing market.
- B.C.'s Rental Assistance Program rates increased by 17%.

Helping Families With Children

NEW BC Child Opportunity Benefit:

Non-taxable monthly support payments for families with children under 18 years old or up to \$1600 for one; \$2600 for two; \$3400 for three; etc. Child Care Fee Reduction Initiative: Saving families up to \$4,200/ year per child.

Shelter Aid for Elderly Residents (SAFER) rates increased by by 42%.

Benefit:

- Modernizing the Residential Tenancy Act (RTA).
- New province-wide rent banks to provide low or no-interest, shortterm loans to people at risk of losing housing or basic utilities.

Increasing Access to Child Care:

22,000 new licensed child care spaces, training more Early Childhood Educators (ECEs), and increasing wages for ECEs at licensed davcares.

- Investing in new hospitals and Urgent Family Care Centres.
- Insulin pumps for those with Type 1 Diabetes now covered for all ages.
- \$1.048 billion in total funding to improve services for seniors home and community care, residential care, and assisted living.
- Improving access to mental health care.
- Eliminating or reducing Pharmacare deductibles for 240,000 families.
- Performing 44,000 more MRIs than last year to improve access to care.

Supporting Those Who Need It Most

- Saving households up to \$1800/year by eliminating MSP Premiums as of January 1, 2020.
- Effective February 19, 2019, eliminating new interest on B.C. student loans.
- Reducing Fair Pharmacare deductibles and family maximums for low income households. Deductibles have been entirely eliminated for those with less than \$30k net income.
- Income assistance and disability payments increased by an additional \$50/month, for a total increase of \$150/

month since the decade long freeze on rates was lifted in 2017.

- Increasing support payments to foster parents, adoptive caregivers, and Community Living BC (CLBC) home-share providers for the first time in over 10 years and providing these supports to extended family members caring for children.
- TogetherBC, B.C.'s first-ever poverty reduction strategy, aims to reduce overall poverty rates by 25% and child poverty rates by 50% within 5 years.

The North Shore has received provincial funding for 240 new child care spaces so far.



B.C. is moving forward on a new state-of-the-art acute care facility at Lions Gate Hospital with 108 single-bed rooms and eight new operating rooms.



The North Shore Neighborhood House has been selected to host a new provincial pilot project that delivers \$200/month child care.



Mountainside Secondary will get seismic upgrades; Handsworth Secondary and Argyle Secondary will get seismically-sound replacement schools; School District of North Vancouver gets a boost in maintenance funding.



MLA Ma has been engaging with North Shore youth about the issues that matter to them.





North Vancouver will be getting two new provinciallyfunded affordable housing projects: a 106-unit seniors' housing complex and a 90-unit family-oriented project.



The North Shore Youth Safe House, which takes in upwards of 150 youth per year, has stable funding from the province for the first time in its 10-year history.





Marine-Main B-Line



Lower Lynn Improvement Project

This project will improve east-west connections for local drivers near the Ironworkers Memorial



Bridge by separating local and highway traffic. This project is anticipated to reduce travel time during rush hours and reduce the risks of crashes along that stretch of highway by one-third. The Lower Lynn Project is expected to be fully complete in 2021.

Faster Crash Clearing

INSTPP identified the need to expedite incident-clearing or the Iron Workers Memorial and Lions Gate bridges, where a minor crash can result in frustrating delays and traffic jams. Modernized regulations on mandatory police reporting, new real-time digital message displays, and improved highway maintenance contracts that ensure robust 24-7 standby towtruck services at the bridges will work to improve how quickly North Shore traffic recovers after minor collisions.

Third SeaBus: The Burrard Chinook

Named the Burrard Chinook, this new SeaBus will be put into service in 2019 and will increase peak period sailing frequency to once every 10 minutes.

Terminal and Transit Exchange Upg

Improvements for the Waterfront SeaBus Terminal includes new escalators, elevators, stairs, and seismic upgrades. The Lonsdale Quay Transit Exchange and Phibbs Transit Exchange will also be receiving upgrades to support service improvements while improving the comfort and safety of passengers.
